**Sub: PRADHAN MANTRI FASAL BIMA YOJANA (PMFBY) - Implementation during Rabi 2017-18 Crop Season.**

Government have been pleased to decide to implement PRADHAN MANTRI FASAL BIMA YOJANA (PMFBY), during Rabi 2017-18 Crop Season in the State.

1. Administrative Approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare for implementation of PMFBY has been communicated in their letter No. 13015/03/2016-Credit-II dated 23.02.2016.

The issue of implementation of PMFBY and declaration of notified insurance units and crops for Rabi 2017-18 season and other related issues were discussed at length by the SLCCCI in the 46<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 16.11.2017.

**2. Farmers Covered**

All farmers growing the notified crops in the notified areas are eligible for coverage. However, farmers should have insurable interest for the notified/ insured crops. The non-loanee farmers are required to submit necessary documentary evidence of land records prevailing in the State (Records of Right (RoR), Land possession Certificate (LPC) etc.) and/ or applicable contract/agreement details/ other documents notified/ permitted by concerned State Government.

**i. Compulsory Component**

All farmers availing Seasonal Agricultural Operations (SAO) loans from Financial Institutions (i.e. loanee farmers) for the notified crop(s) would be covered compulsorily. All non-defaulter loanee farmers shall be covered under the programme based on the Credit limit sanctioned against them.

**ii. Voluntary Component**

The Scheme would be optional for the non-loanee farmers. Special efforts shall be made to ensure maximum coverage of SC/ ST/ Women farmers under the scheme. Budget allocation and utilization under these segments should be in proportion of land holding of SC/ ST/ General along with Women in the respective state/ cluster. Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs) may be involved at various stages of implementation of crop insurance schemes particularly in the identification of the

crops and beneficiaries, extension and awareness creation amongst farmers, obtaining feed-back of the farmers while assessing the claim for prevented sowing, localized perils, post-harvest losses and advance payment of claims etc.

### 3. Crops Covered under PMFBY

During Rabi 2017-18, the notified crops for insurance under PMFBY are Paddy, Groundnut, Mustard, Potato, Blackgram, Greengram, Sugarcane, Onion and Sunflower.

### 4. Unit Area of Crop Insurance are as follows.

1.	Paddy	Gram Panchayats (including Municipalities, NACs)
2.	Groundnut, Mustard, Potato, Blackgram and Greengram, Sugarcane, Onion and Sunflower	Block

### 5. Clusters and Implementing Agency

As per the operational guidelines of PMFBY, 30 districts of the State have been grouped into 6 clusters for smooth implementation of the scheme during Rabi 2016. Four Insurance Companies have been selected for the six clusters to implement the PMFBY during Rabi 2017-18 in the State. Name of the Clusters and Implementing Agencies (Insurance Companies) are indicated below.

#### 7. Indemnity Level

The Indemnity Level for all crops will be 70%

### 8. Premium Rates and Premium Subsidy

The Actuarial Premium Rate (APR) would be charged under PMFBY by Implementing Agency (IA). The rate of Insurance Charges payable by the farmer will be as per the following table:

Sl. No.	Crops	Maximum Insurance Charges payable by farmers (% of Sum Insured)
1	Paddy, Ground nut, Mustard, Black gram and Green gram & Sunflower	1.5 % of sum insured or Actuarial rate, whichever is less
2	Potato, Onion & Sugarcane	5% of sum insured or Actuarial rate, whichever is less

Difference between actuarial premium Rate and farmers premium will be subsidized by State Government and Government of India on 50:50 basis.

The actuarial premium rate and farmers premium rate shall be as per the rate indicated at **Annexure-6**.

### 9. Coverage of Risks

The following stages of the crops and risks leading to crop loss shall be covered under the Scheme.

#### (a) Prevented Sowing

Insurance coverage to farmers shall be provided in case of wide spread incidence of eligible risks affecting crops in more than 75% of area sown in a notified unit at early stage leading to total loss of crop or the farmers are not in a position to either sow or transplant the crop.

(b) **Standing Crop** (Sowing to Harvesting): Comprehensive risk insurance shall be provided to cover yield losses due to non- preventable risks, viz. Drought, Dry spells, Flood, Inundation, Pests and Diseases, Landslides, Natural Fire and Lightening, Storm, Hailstorm, Cyclone, Typhoon, Tempest, Hurricane and Tornado.

(c) **Post-Harvest Losses** : Coverage shall be available only upto maximum period of two weeks from harvesting for paddy in case of occurrence of cyclone, cyclonic rains and unseasonal rains.

(d) **Localized Calamities**: Loss/ damage resulting from occurrence of identified localized risks of hailstorm, landslide, and Inundation affecting isolated farms in the notified area.

(e) **On Account Payment of Claims due to Mid-Season Adversity** : Insured farmers shall be provided immediate relief in case of adverse seasonal conditions during the crop season viz. floods, prolonged dry spells, severe drought etc , wherein expected yield during the season is likely to be less than 50% of Threshold yield.

10. The rainfall data will be obtained from two sources namely, Automatic Rain Gauges (ARG) of Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) (Annexure- A) and Manual Rain Gauges of SRC (Annexure -B).

11. **General Exclusions:** Losses arising out of war and nuclear risks, malicious damage and other preventable risks shall be excluded

12. Loss assessment procedure and submission of reports of claims for different risk scenarios shall be carried out as laid down in the Resolutions of Department of Agriculture & Farmers Empowerment as noted below

(i) Mid-season adversity-Resolution No.14470/Ag, dated 31.08.2016, (ii) Post-harvest losses - Resolution No 14482/Ag, dated 31.08 2016, (iii) Localized Risks - Resolution No.14491/Ag, dated 31.08.2016 and (iv) Prevented Sowing-Resolution No 13823/Ag, dated 31.8.2017 (Annexure-C)

13. **Yield data** : The cut off date for submission of actual yield data to the IAs for Rabi 2017-18 season shall be as per the following schedule

However CCEs should be made continuously as per harvest in each district without awaiting for the last date and data should be processed district wise for assessment of claims to provide crop insurance benefit to farmers early.

#### 15. Sum Insured /Coverage Limit

Sum Insured per hectare for both loanee and non-loanee farmers will be same and equal to the Scale of Finance as decided by the District Level Technical Committee, and would be pre-declared by SLCCCI and notified. No other calculation of Scale of Finance will be applicable. Sum Insured for individual farmer is equal to the Scale of Finance per hectare multiplied by area of the notified crop proposed by the farmer for insurance. 'Area under cultivation' shall always be expressed in 'hectare'.

The District-wise, Crop-wise Scale of finance (in Rs./Hectare) for Rabi-2017-18 season is appended at Annexure- 7.

**16. Publicity:** Large scale awareness generation programme shall be taken to sensitize the farmers about the various features of the programme. The Implementing Agencies are also required to make publicity campaign in a larger scale.

The Department of Agriculture & Farmers Empowerment, Planning & Convergence Department (Directorate of Economics & Statistics) and Cooperation Department should share all the available information with regard to crop area, yield and insurance payouts made with the insurance companies

17. The insurance companies should strictly follow their role & responsibilities as specified in operational guide lines of PMFBY.

Other details can be ascertained from the District Central Cooperative Banks, Branches of the Commercial Banks and Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) functioning in different service areas and from Regional Office of the concerned Insurance Companies.

**Sub: Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY); on account payment of claims due to mid-season adversity.**

- Ref:** (1) Resolution No. 2935 dated 12.04.2016 of Cooperation Department.  
(2) Resolution No.4228 dated 30.05.2016 of Cooperation Department.  
(3) Operational Guidelines of PMFBY by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare of GoI.

Under the PMFBY, immediate relief is to be provided to insured farmers in case of any adverse seasonal condition during the crop season (**mid-season adversity**) viz. floods, prolonged dry spells, severe moisture stress, droughts etc., **wherein expected yield is likely to be less than 50% of threshold yield.**

Accordingly, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to lay down the following modalities for loss assessment procedures and submission of reports of claims due to all such mid-season adversities.

1. The unit of payment of claim due to mid-season adversity shall be the Insurance Unit notified by Government of Odisha, from time to time.
2. For the purpose of assessing crop damage relating to mid season-adversity, the **Joint Committee** of State Government and the Insurers, as envisaged under the operational guidelines of PMFBY, shall be the District Level Monitoring Committee (**DLMC**) constituted vide Reference at (1) above.
3. The District Level Monitoring Committee (**DLMC**) under the Chairmanship of the District Collector shall hold regular meetings and send a report on any mid-season adversity during the crop season **within the date defined in the notification on crop insurance**. This should be based on proxy indicators laid down in the PMFBY guidelines which are as follows:
  - i) Rainfall data;
  - ii) Other weather data, like prolonged dry spells;
  - iii) Satellite imagery and information derived from satellite data like Normalised Difference Vegetation Index (NDVI) and Normalised Difference Water Index (NDWI);



- iv) Inundation of crop due to floods;
- v) Media reports;
- vi) Crop condition reports by district level officials of Agriculture & Farmers' Empowerment and Revenue & Disaster Management Departments.

**The Collector, as Chairman of the DLMC, shall send the report to the Director, Agriculture & Food Production (DA&FP), who will place all such reports before the State level Crop Weather Watch Group.**

4. The provision for assessment of loss & claims will thereafter be invoked by the State Government through the State level **Crop Weather Watch Group**, headed by the Agriculture Production Commissioner/ Principal Secretary of A&FE Department, through a direction to all concerned, including the Insurance Company. Such direction should be based on the recommendation of the DLMC.
5. On the directions of the State Government, the Collector of the concerned district will arrange joint inspections of the affected area by the Insurance Company and the State Government officials who are members of the **Block Level Monitoring Committee (BLMC)** constituted vide Resolution cited under reference at (1) above.
6. The BLMC along with Insurance Company shall assess the affected area and extent of yield loss through field verification by way of eye estimation, for each village in the notified insurance unit and submit a report to DLMC in the **Format-I** enclosed **within 7 days of the direction of the State Government.**
7. **The Chairman, DLMC** i.e., the Collector of the district should go through the report of the BLMC and give her/his views and observations to the State Government i.e., Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha, immediately on receipt of the report from BLMC.
8. The State Level Monitoring Committee (**SLMC**) constituted vide reference at (1) above shall finalise the notified insurance unit eligible for on account payment for mid season adversity and payment to be made to the farmers insured under the PMFBY.
9. Basing on the decisions of the SLMC, the DA&FP shall issue a notification. **The Insurance Company shall make the on account payment of claims to the eligible insured farmers within one week of the said notification.** These claims would be adjusted from the end season area approach yield based claims.

**Ref:** (1) Resolution No. 2935 dated 12.04.2016 of Cooperation Department.

(2) Resolution No.4228 dated 30.05.2016 of Cooperation Department.

(3) Operational Guidelines of PMFBY by Department of Agriculture Cooperation & Farmers Welfare of GoI.

Under the PMFBY, immediate relief is to be provided to insured farmers at individual farm level in case of crop losses due to occurrence of **Post Harvest Losses**.


Accordingly, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to lay down the following modalities for loss assessment procedures and submission of reports of claims due to all such localized calamities.

1. The claims due to post harvest losses by the insured farmers will be applicable for 3 risk scenarios viz,
  - a. Cyclone
  - b. Cyclonic Rains &
  - c. Unseasonal Rains.
2. This will be applicable to the crop only when it is in "cut & spread" condition in the field for the sole purpose of drying, for a maximum period up to 14 days after the date of harvest.
3. The unit of insurance, loss assessment & claim settlement shall be an individual farmer. However, if the affected area under a notified crop is >25% of the total insured area in a notified insurance unit, all eligible farmers (who have taken insurance for the notified & damaged crop, and have intimated about occurrence of the calamity in their individual farms (within the stipulated time i.e., 48 hours) in the notified insurance unit would be deemed to have suffered harvest loss and would be eligible for financial support. In case of affected area is > 25% of the total insured area, the percentage of loss will be determined by sample survey of affected area by the BLMC (treated as Joint Committee, for the purpose)
4. As a first hand information, the farmer may call the "Toll Free Telephone Number" of the concerned Insurance Company & provide relevant information regarding his/her name, locality, plot no/survey no wise insured crop & area affected etc. If it is not possible to make a call farmer may collect the "Loss Intimation Form" available at the Office of the Assistant Agriculture Officer of the Block and also the Village Agricultural Worker/ Agriculture Overseer. The Loss Intimation Form is also available in the "Agrisnet Odisha" website i.e.,

<http://agrisnetodisha.ori.nic.in>. The reporting can also be made at the nearest Bank Branches or Office of the Insurance Company or its Agency, the claim can also be submitted at the nearest bank or PACS or Office of the Assistant Agriculture Officer, along with local newspaper cuttings, if any. **This Intimation should be provided within 48 hours of occurrence of Loss.**

5. **After the initial reporting, the farmer is required to submit the Loss Intimation form along with documentary evidence within 7 days of occurrence of localized calamity. A picture of crop damage captured through Mobile Phone or any camera can be attached to the application form. All the Loss Intimation Form received by Banks/PACS/VAWs/ AOs/Insurance Agencies will be forwarded to the Block AAO within 24 hours. The Block AAO will then intimate the Agent of the Insurance Company at Block level within next 24 hours.**
6. On receipt of intimation, for the purpose of assessing harvest loss, the Block Level Monitoring Committee, along with Loss Assessor engaged by the Insurance company should visit the affected field, conduct a joint inspection and collect the information in prescribed proforma, given at **Annexure-I**. However, failure on the part of the Insurance Company to timely engage Loss Assessor will not deprive the farmers of his due insurance claims, if any.
7. While making an assessment of loss, the BLMC has to keep in mind the stage of the crop and accordingly decide upon the expenditure incurred towards input up to that stage. BLMC may refer to the cited example placed at Annexure-II for the purpose.
8. Upon receipt of the report from the BLMC, the Chairman DLMC i.e. the District Collector should go through the report and immediately submit the same to the State Government i.e. the Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha with his views and observations. The DA&FP will place the report of the Collector before the Chairman SLMC.
9. The State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC), constituted vide reference at (1), shall finalise the notified insurance unit (if required, individual farmers also) and direct the Insurance Company for on account payment due to localized calamity.
10. The total time frame for taking a decision on the claims of post harvest loss by the farmers is 10 days only. Hence, the BLMC should complete the entire process within 3 days & the Chairman DLMC should submit his report in another 3 days so as to enable SLMC to take a decision within the stipulated time frame.
11. For all issues relating to claims & loss assessment, as well as claim settlement, the Operational Guidelines of PFI&BY shall be followed.

**Sub: Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY); on account payment of claims due to localized risks.**

**Ref:** (1) Resolution No. 2935 dated 12.04.2016 of Cooperation Department.  
(2) Resolution No.4228 dated 30.05.2016 of Cooperation Department.  
(3) Operational Guidelines of PMFBY by Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare of GoI.

Under the PMFBY, immediate relief is to be provided to insured farmers at individual farm level in case of crop losses due to occurrence of **localized perils/calamities** viz, landslide, hailstorm and inundation **affecting part of a notified unit or a plot.**

Accordingly, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to lay down the following modalities for loss assessment procedures and submission of reports of claims due to all such localized calamities.

1. Three risk scenarios i.e. Hail Storm & Landslide which are defined as follows will be covered as localized calamities:
  - i) **Hailstorm:** A thunderstorm which produces hail (ice pellet) that falls on the insured standing crop causing extensive damages to the plant population and/or resulting in yield loss.
  - ii) **Landslide:** Mass movement of rock, debris or soil down a slope of land, which damages the standing crop.
  - iii) **Inundation:** Crop covered with water, especially flood water for a prolonged causing damage to the crop
2. The unit of insurance, loss assessment & claim settlement shall be an **individual farmer.**

3. However, **if the affected area under a notified crop is >25%** of the total insured area in a notified insurance unit, all eligible farmers (who have taken insurance for the notified & damaged crop, and have intimated about occurrence of the calamity in their individual farms (within the stipulated time i.e., 48 hours) in the notified insurance unit would be deemed to have suffered localized loss and would be eligible for financial support.
4. As a first hand information, the farmer may call the "Toll Free Telephone Number" of the concerned Insurance Company & provide relevant information regarding his/her name, locality, plot no./survey no. wise insured crop & area affected etc. If it is not possible to make a call farmer may collect the "Loss Intimation Form" available at the Office of the Assistant Agriculture Officer of the Block and also the Village Agricultural Worker/ Agriculture Overseer. The Loss Intimation Form is also available in the "Agrisnet Odisha" website i.e. <http://agrisnetodisha.or.in>. The reporting can also be made at the nearest Bank Branches or Office of the Insurance Company or its Agency, the claim can also be submitted at the nearest bank or PACS or Office of the Assistant Agriculture Officer, along with local newspaper cuttings, if any. **This Intimation should be provided within 48 hours of occurrence of Loss.**
5. **After the initial reporting, the farmer is required to submit the Loss Intimation form along with documentary evidence within 7 days of occurrence of localized calamity. A picture of crop damage captured through Mobile Phone or any camera can be attached to the application form. All the Loss Intimation Form received by Banks/PACS/VAWs/AOs/Insurance Agencies will be forwarded to the Block AAO within 24 hours. The Block AAO will then intimate the Agent of the Insurance Company at Block level within next 24 hours.**
6. For the purpose of assessing crop damage relating to localized calamities, the **Joint Committee** of State Government and the Insurers, as envisaged under the operational guidelines of PMFBY, shall be the District Level Monitoring Committee (**DLMC**) constituted vide Reference at (1) above. The District Level Monitoring Committee (**DLMC**) under the Chairmanship of the District Collector shall hold immediate meeting after occurrence of the localized calamity. The provision for assessment of loss & claims will be invoked by the DLMC which will then direct the BLMC to take up a joint inspection of the affected area under intimation to the Insurance Company. The decision of DLMC should be based on proxy indicators laid down in the PMFBY guidelines, which are as follows:

- i) Reports of the district level officials of Agriculture & Farmers Empowerment and Revenue & Disaster Management Departments.
- ii) Media reports;

7. On receipt of intimation from the D\_LMC, the Block Level Monitoring Committee (BLMC), along with Loss Assessor engaged by the Insurance company shall visit the affected field and collect required information in the prescribed proforma, given at **Annexure-I**.
8. Maximum pay out under this provision would be in proportion to the cost of inputs, incurred up to occurrence of insured peril, subject to sum insured.
9. While making an assessment of the loss, the BLMC has to keep in mind the stage of the crop and accordingly decide upon the expenditure incurred towards input up to that stage. BLMC may refer to the cited example placed at **Annexure-II**, for the purpose.
10. Upon receipt of the report from BLMC, the **Chairman DLMC** should go through the report and immediately submit the same to the State Government i.e., **Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha** with his views and observations. The DA&FP will place the report of the Collector before the Chairman SLMC.
11. The State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) constituted vide reference at (1) above shall finalise the notified insurance unit (along with the individual farmers, if any) and issue a direction to the Insurance Company for on account payment to all the claimants. The Insurance Company will complete the claim settlement in the next 15 days.
12. **The total time frame for loss assessment shall be 10 days only.** Hence, the BLMC should complete the entire process within 3 days & the chairman D\_LMC should submit his report within another 3 days so as to enable SLMC to complete the entire process within the stipulated time frame.
13. For all issues relating to claims & loss assessment, as well as claim settlement, the Operational Guidelines of PMFBY shall be followed.

(3)Operational Guideline of PMFBY by Deptt. of Agril Cooperation & Farmers Welfare, Govt of India.

Under the PMFBY, immediate relief is to be provided to the insured farmers in case of any prevented sowing and failure of sowing/Planting/Germination claims where in 75% or more area of the insurance unit in case of major crop i.e. Paddy remains unsown / unplanted or there is failure in germination of the sown/planted crop by 15<sup>th</sup> September.

1. The unit of claim due to prevented sowing shall be the "Insurance unit" notified by the Government of Odisha, from time to time.

2. For the purpose of assessing Crop damage/uncovered area due to prevented sowing & failure of sowing/Planting/germination, the Joint Committee of State Government and the Insurance of PMFBY, shall be the District Level Monitoring Committee (DLMC) constituted by vide reference at (1) above).

3. The District Level Monitoring Committee shall regularly review the progress of Crop sowing situation in Kharif and Rabi seasons (Preferably on weekly basis) and upon receipt of information regarding wide spread incidence of prevented failed sowing and prevented planting/Germination shall direct the Block Level Monitoring Committee to inspect the affected area and report on the following factors as detailed below within 7 days

a) Insurance Unit wise (i.e. C.P wise Normal sown area vis-a-vis area sown/planted in Proforma-I.

b) Insurance unit wise area in which the Crop (Paddy) could not be sown/planted/there is failure in germination in Proforma-II.

(c) Information on details of month wise-block wise Normal rain fall (Long Period Average) vis-à-vis Actual rainfall in Proforma-III (Please refer Annexure I)

4. The BLMC along with representative of the Insurance Company shall assess the affected area in Proforma-I & Proforma-II and submit it to DLMC within 7 days.
5. The DLMC shall go through the reports of BLMC, analyse the same and furnish a report to the Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha with his views and observations. The DA & FP, (O) will place the report of the Collector before the Chairman, State Level Monitoring Committee (SLMC) along with his views within 7 days of receipt of the report from BLMC.
6. The SLMC on receipt of reports from DLMC shall analyse the same and invoke the prevented sowing through notification to be issued by the Agril. & F.E. Department.
7. Then the Insurance Companies shall take up necessary steps for payment of claims (25% of sum insured) to the insured farmers as per list furnished to them by Banks/CSC/Insurance Agents/directly by farmers.
8. The Policy shall then stand terminated.
